## ITS launches interface for yard systems

Software developer International Terminal Solutions (ITS) is aiming to simplify the movement, storage and retrieval of containers with its new interface for container yards' real-time location systems.

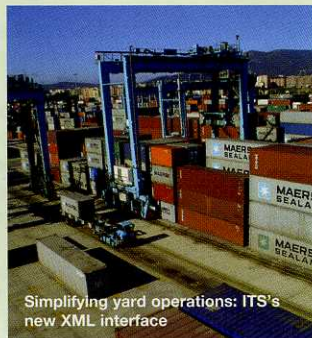
Using standard Navis XML protocols, the software upgrade is designed to connect to the Navis Sparcs terminal operating system.

ITS says the development will give terminal managers 'greater operational visibility'.

The company anticipates the first RTG implementation will take place in the second quarter of 2007 at the Port of Algeciras in Spain, which handles more than 3 million TEU per year.

Later in the year ITS expects a further two RTG terminals in North America to connect their systems to Sparcs using the XML interface.

International Terminal Solutions will be on Stand E1 at TOC2007 Europe.
